

**Mo‘olelo no ka Hui Kūkā ‘ana
o ka Papa Alaka‘i o
Ke Kula Niihau O Kekaha**

Po‘akolu, 15 ‘Apelila 2026

Ua mālama ‘ia ka hui kūkā ‘ana o ka Papa Alaka‘i ma ka lumi nui o ke kula. ‘O nā lālā i hō‘ea mai, ‘o ia nō ka Pelekikena Keli‘i Vidinha, ka Hope Pelekikena Kapua Phillips (z), ke Kākau ‘Ōlelo Hōkūlani Cleeland, ka lālā kū kūlana Tia Koerte, a m ke kanakia mālama kālā Glen Aoki (z). ‘A‘ole i hō‘ea ma ka Pu‘ukū Jolina Felix-Keamoai a me ka lālā Milimili Nizo. Ma o ka Zoom ka hui ‘ana o ka po‘e i hō‘ike ‘ia ka (z).

Ka Wehe ‘ana:

I ka hola 3:10 o ka ‘auinalā Po‘akolu, lā 15 o ‘Apelila 2026, na Keli‘i i wehe i ka hui kūkā ‘ana me ka Pule Lanakila, a nāna nō i alaka‘i i ke kūkā ‘ana i nā kumuhana ma ka papa kumumana‘o o ka hui kūkā. *At 3:10 p.m. on Wednesday, April 15, 2026, Keli‘i opened the meeting with the Pule Lanakila, and he also led the discussion of items on the agenda.*

Ka Hui Kūkā ‘ana:

1. Ka Mo‘olelo Kahiko: Ua ‘āpono ‘ia ka mo‘olelo o ka hui kūkā ‘ana o ka lā 21 o Ianuali e like me ka mea i kāka‘ahi mua ‘ia. *The minutes of the January 21 meeting were approved as previously distributed.*

2. Ka Papa Kumumana‘o no kēia Hui Kūkā ‘ana: Ua ‘āpono ‘ia ka papa kumumana‘o i hāpai ‘ia e like me ka mea i kāka‘ahi ‘ia me ka ho‘okomo ‘ana i ho‘okahi mea ma lalo o ka māhele no na kumuhana hou aku no kekahi kulekele olakino. *The proposed agenda was approved as distributed with the addition of one item under new business for a wellness policy.*

3. Ka Hō‘ike Kālā: Ua hō‘ike o Glen i ka mo‘olelo kālā no ka hapahā ‘ekolu o ka makahiki kula 2025-26. Ua wehewehe ‘o ia i kekahi mau māhele ma ka hō‘ike, a laila, ua ‘āpono ‘ia. *Glen presented the third-quarter financial report for the school year 2025-26. He explained a few things about the report, and it was approved*

4. Ka Hō‘ike Po‘o Kumu: Eia kekahi o nā mea hou a Tia i hāpai ai ma kāna hō‘ike.
Pahuhopu 2: Ke holomua nei ka pa‘i puke ‘ana, a ua pau no ke kula pēpē a hiki i ka papa 5. E mau ana ka hana ma nā puke o ke kula waena a me ke kula ki‘eki‘e. Eia nō ho‘i kekahi mau hana

kūikawā no ka hapahā ‘ehā o kēia makahiki: E mālama ‘ia ana ka hō‘ike Ho‘olaule‘a Puke i ka lā 24 o ‘Apelila. E mālama ‘ia ana ka Lā Hānau o ke kula i ka lā 13 o Mei. Aia ana ka hemo kula i ka lā 26 o Mei. **Pahuhopu 3:** Ua ‘āpono ‘ia kekahi mau ha‘awina kālā e ke Kula o Kamehameha a me ka Office of Hawaiian Affairs. E mau ana ke kālā mai ke Aupuni mai. **Pahuhopu 4:** He 50 haumāna ma ke kula i kēia manawa. **Pahuhopu 5:** ‘Āpono ‘ia kekahi mau kālā mai ka Office of Hawaiian Affairs mai no ka hale kula, e like me ke kūkulu ‘ana i kekahi hale li‘ili‘i ma hope of ke kula, ke kōkua ‘ana i ka uku i nā ‘aiē no ka uila a me ka wai, a e kūkā ‘ia ana kekahi mau mea hou e like me ke kāhea pau ahi. **Pahuhopu 7:** Ua loa‘a mai ka hō‘ike o ka hui WASC no ka holomua o ke kula, a pono e ho‘ouna i nā hana e hana ‘ia ana ma ka lā 22 o ‘Apelila. No ka hō‘ike hana no ka WASC, na Keli‘i e alaka‘i i ka māhele 1, na Kapua ka māhele 2, a na Tia ka māhele 3. Eia kekahi, ke hō‘ole nei ke kula i ke kālā Title 1 no kēia makahiki kula a‘e.

*Here are some new items brought up by Tia in her report. **Goal 2:** As for the students’ books for this year, from preschool through grade 5 have been completed, and work continues for the books for middle and high school. The Ho‘olaule‘a Puke event will be held on April 24, the polokalamu Lā Hānau will be on May 13, and graduation will be on May 26. **Goal 3:** Various funding as been approved from Kamehameha Schools and the Office of Hawaiian Affairs. State funding continues. **Goal 4:** Current enrollment is 50 students. **Goal 5:** Facilities funding from the Office of Hawaiian Affairs such as for building an open-air pavilion, for help in paying for utilities such as electricity and water, and at a meeting on April 24, funding for a new Fire Alarm system will be discussed. **Goal 7:** The WASC report has been received regarding work at the school, and a report on our action plan is due on April 22. For the action plan, Keli‘i will be responsible for part 1, Kapua for part 2, and Tia for part 3. In addition, the school is refusing to take Title I funding for next year.*

5. Kumuhana Hou: Ua ‘āpono ‘ia ke Kulekele Ola Kino no ke kula no kēia makahiki kula. *The Wellness Policy was approved.*

6. Ka ‘Āpono ‘ana i nā Mea a pau: Ke ‘āpono maoli nei ka Papa Alaka‘i i nā mea a pau i hō‘ike ‘ia i loko o kēia mo‘olelo. *Everything covered in these minutes is hereby officially approved by the Governing Board.*
