## Moʻolelo no ka Hui Kūkā ʻana o ka Papa Alakaʻi o Ke Kula Niʻihau O Kekaha Poʻahā, 19 ʻOkakopa 2017

Ua mālama 'ia ka hui kūkā 'ana o ka Papa Alaka'i i loko o ka lumi kamepiula o Ke Kula Ni'ihau O Kekaha. 'O nā lālā i hō'ea mai, 'o ia nō ka Pelekikena Kapua Phillips, ka Hope Pelekikena Koana Acoba, ke Kākau 'Ōlelo Kekoa Catiggay Kanahele, ka Pu'ukū Ka'imi Strickland, nā lālā Kalena Kagawa, a me Hōkūlani Cleeland, a me ka lālā kū kūlana Tia Koerte. 'A'ole i hō'ea mai nā lālā Sariah Kanahele, Bo Kamāla, a me Lissa Dunford.

## Ka Wehe 'ana:

I ka hola 3:01 o ka 'auinalā Po'ahā, lā 19 o 'Okakopa 2017, na Ka'imi i wehe i ka hui kūkā 'ana me ka Pule Kahikolu, a laila, na ka Pelekikena Kapua i alaka'i i ke kūkā 'ana ma ka hui kūkā.

## Ka Hui Kūkā 'ana:

**1. Ka Moʻolelo Kahiko:** Ua ʻāpono ʻia ka moʻolelo no ka hui kūkā ʻana o ka lā 20 o lulai 2017 e like me ka mea i kākaʻahi ia. *The minutes of the July 20, 2017, meeting were approved as distributed.* 

Noi 'ia: Kekoa Kōkua 'ia: Kaimi

2. Ka Papa Kumumana'o no kēia Hui Kūkā 'ana: Ua 'āpono 'ia ka papa kumumana'o i hāpai 'ia e like me ka mea i kāka'ahi 'ia. The proposed agenda was approved as distributed.

**Noi 'ia:** Kekoa **Kōkua 'ia**: Hōkūlani

3. Ka Hōʻike Moʻohelu Kālā: Na ke Poo Kumu Tia i ʻōlelo mai ua maikaʻi ka hōʻike a ka poʻe luna hōʻoia kālā, a pono e hoʻouna ʻia i ke Komikina ma mua o ka lā 1 o Nowemapa. Hoʻokahi hemahema nō naʻe i hōʻike ʻia, me he mea lā ʻaʻole i hoʻolilo ʻia \$95,120.23 o ka haʻawina kālā Impact Aid, no laila, ua pono e hoʻoneʻe aku i kekahi mau lilo i mea e hōʻike ʻia ai ua lilo nō. Ua noʻonoʻo ʻia hiki

ke ho'one'e i ke koena o ka uku no ke ka'a 'ōhua hou i laila. No ka loa'a 'ole o Lissa ma ka hui kūkā, ua kelepona 'ia 'o ia e pili ana i ka hō'ike kālā no ka hapahā mua, a 'ōlelo maila 'o ia e leka uila 'o ia i nā lālā ma hope o ka hopena pule. Po'o Kumu Tia reported that the financial audit was satisfactory, and it must be submitted to the Commission by November 1. One problem that was identified was that it appears that none of the \$95,120.23 of the Impact Aid grant was spent, so some expenses need to be moved to that account to show that it was spent. One suggestion was to move the remaining charges for the new bus there. Because Lissa was not available at the meeting, she was phoned to ask about the quarterly financial report, and she said she would email it to the members after the weekend.

4. Ka Hōʻike Poʻo Kumu: Eia kekahi mau manaʻo nui ma ka hōʻike a Po'o Kumu Tia: **Pahuhopu 2**: Ke haku 'ia nei ka papa ha'awina ma ka 'ōlelo Ni'ihau no nā papa mālaa'o a hiki i ka papa 2, a he ho'omaka kēja no ka hana 'ana i nā papa ha'awina no nā pae 'ē a'e a pau a hiki i ka makahiki 2023. **Pahuhopu 3**: Mau nō ka loa'a 'ana mai o 'ekolu 'ano ha'awina kālā mai iā Kamehameha mai no ke kula pēpē a me nā papa mālaa'o a hiki i ka papa 12. **Pahuhopu 5**: Ua kipa mai kekahi po'e mai ka Hui Rotary o Po'ipū, a no'ono'o ja po'e hiki ke hoʻomaka ka hoʻonui ʻana i ka hale kula ma ʻekolu ʻanuʻu hana: (1) ho'onui i ka hale meahana a e lilo ia i kula pēpē (hiki nō paha ke hana 'ia i kēia makahiki); (2) ho'onui i nā lumi papa ma ka lānai o hope o ka hale me ke kūkulu 'ana i lānai hou ma waho o kēlā; (3) hoʻonui i nā lumi ma ka lānai o mua o ka hale me ka ho'ololi 'ana i ke ke'ena a me ka hale waihona puke. Pahuhopu 6: Ua haku 'ia kekahi ha'awina hou no ke a'o 'ana i nā kāpana o ka 'ōlelo Ni'ihau i nā kamali'i li'ili'i, a kapa 'ia ka inoa o ia ha'awina 'o "Kealapito." **Pahuhopu 7**: Pono e ho'opau 'ia ka loiloi 'ana i ke po'o kumu. Eia nō kekahi mana'o: no ke emi 'ana o nā kamali'i ma ke kula pēpē i kēja makahiki, ua loli nā kuleana o Kumu Ka'imi, a he kōkua nui ia ma nā 'ano hana like 'ole ma ke kula. *The following* are some of the main ideas from Administrator Tia's report: Goal 2: A Ni'ihau-language curriculum is being developed for kindergarten through grade 2, and this is the beginning of the development of Ni'ihau curricula for all grades through grade 12 to be completed by 2023. **Goal 5**: Visitors from the Poʻipū Rotary Club toured the campus, and they believe the goal to enlarge the school can be carried out in three phases: (1) the current tool shed can be enlarged and become the preschool (this might be able to

be accomplished this school year); (2) classrooms on the mauka side of the building can be enlarged by using the existing lānai and adding a small new one outside of that; (3) rooms on the makai side of the building can be enlarged to include the front lānai, reconfiguring at least the office and the library. **Goal 6**: A new system for teaching syllables in the Ni'ihau dialect has been created, and it is called Kealapito. **Goal 7**: Evaluation of the administrator needs to be completed. One additional item is that because of small preschool enrollment this year, Kumu Ka'imi's responsibilities have been revised, and the change has proved to be beneficial to various aspects of work at the school.
