

**Mo'olelo no ka Hui Kūkā 'ana  
o ka Papa Alaka'i o  
Ke Kula Ni'ihau O Kekaha  
Po'ahā, 20 'Apelila 2017**

Ua mālama 'ia ka hui kūkā 'ana o ka Papa Alaka'i i loko o ka lumi kamepiula o Ke Kula Ni'ihau O Kekaha. 'O nā lālā i hō'ea mai, 'o ia nō ka Pelekikena Kapua Phillips, ke Kākau 'Ōlelo Kekoa Catiggay Kanahale, nā lālā 'ē a'e 'o Sariah Kanahale, Kalena Kagawa, Hōkūlani Cleeland, a me ka lālā kū kūlana Tia Koerte. 'A'ole i hō'ea mai ka Hope Pelekikena Koana Acoba, ka Pu'ukū Ka'imi Strickland, a me nā lālā 'o Bo Kamāla lāua 'o Keone Kealoha.

**Ka Wehe 'ana:**

I ka hola 3:11 o ka 'auinalā Po'ahā, lā 20 o 'Apelila 2017, na Kekoa i wehe i ka hui kūkā 'ana me ka Pule Kahikolu, a laila, na ka Pelekikena Kapua i alaka'i i ke kūkā 'ana ma ka hui kūkā.

**Ka Hui Kūkā 'ana:**

1. **Ka Mo'olelo Kahiko:** Ua 'āpono 'ia ka mo'olelo no ka hui kūkā 'ana o ka lā 19 o Ianuali 2017 e like me ka mea i ho'ouna 'ia ma o ka leka uila. *The minutes of the January 19, 2017, meeting were approved as sent through email.*

2. **Ka Papa Kumumana'o no kēia Hui Kūkā 'ana:** Ua 'āpono 'ia ka papa kumumana'o i hāpai 'ia e like me ka mea i ho'ololi 'ia me ka ho'okomo 'ana i ke kumuhana no ka noi kālā Title I. *The proposed agenda was approved as amended by adding the subject of the Title I grant request.*

3. **Ka Hō'ike Mo'ohelu Kālā:** Ma muli o ka hele 'ole 'ana mai o Lissa, 'a'ole i loa'a kekahi hō'ike kālā no ka hapahā 'ekolu o kēia makahiki. Ua noi nō na'e 'o Tia e mālama 'ia ka hui 'ana o kekahi kōmike kūikawā no ka nānā 'ana i ka mo'ohelu kālā no kēia makahiki iho. Ua ho'opa'a 'ia ka hola 3:00 o ka Po'ahā, lā 18 o Mei,

no ka hui 'ana ma ke kula. A laila, ua hō'ike mai 'o Tia i ke kāmua o kāna noi kālā Title I no 'ekolu makahiki; ke noi nei 'o ia i \$15,479 no kēlā me kēia makahiki. 'Āpono 'ia kēia noi kālā. *Due to Lissa's absence, no financial report for third quarter was available. However, Tia requested that an ad hoc committee meet in order to go over the budget for next year. Thursday, May 18, at 3:00 p.m. was chosen to meet at the school. Then Tia presented her draft of a Title I grant request for three years; \$15,479 is being requested for each of the three years. This request was approved.*

4. **Ka Hō'ike Po'o Kumu:** 'O ka hō'ike Title I o luna nei ka mea nui no ka hō'ike po'o kumu, eia na'e kekahi mau mana'o 'ē a'e āna i hāpai aku nei: (a) ke kūkā nei nā kumu a me nā limahana e pili ana i nā waiwai he mea nui no ka po'e Ni'ihau, a e ho'ohana 'ia ana ia mau waiwai no ka hana 'ana i nā papa ha'awina no ke kula; (b) loa'a mai nei kekahi ha'awina kālā no \$8,378.96 mai iā Hawai'i Nutrition Program no ke kū'ai 'ana i pahu hau/pahu pa'a hau hou; (c) ke hana nei nā haumāna ma ka Papa Tui Mau i kekahi mau ha'awina no ke kula, a e mālama 'ia ana kekahi hō'ike'ike i ka hola 5:00 a hiki i ka hola 7:00 o ka Po'alua, lā 27 o Iune, ma ke kula; kono 'ia ka po'e a pau e hele mai a nānā; (d) pono e ho'omana'o i ka loiloi 'ana i ka hana a ke po'o kumu i kēia makahiki ma ka hui kūkā paha o ke kauwela. *The Title I presentation above was the primary part of the principal's report, but the following are some other topics that she brought up: (a) the teachers and staff are discussing the important values of the Ni'ihau community, and these values will be used in developing the curricula for the school; (b) \$8,378.96 has been received from the Hawai'i Nutrition Program in order to purchase a new refrigerator/freezer; (c) students in the Papa Tui Mau Ni'ihau-language class are developing resources for the school, and a presentation of these resources will be held from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 27, at the school; everyone is invited to come and see; (d) we need to remember to evaluate the principal's performance this year at the summer meeting.*
5. **Ke Kipa Waenakonu 'ana no ke Akuloia:** Ho'olaha aku nei 'o Tia ua 'āpono ke kōmike kipa i nā makahiki 'ekolu e koe ana no ke akuloia, eia na'e, aia ka 'āpono kūhelu i ka hui maoli. *Tia announced that the visitation committee recommended that the accreditation be continued for the next three years, but official approval must come from the company.*

6. **No nā Ka‘a ‘Ōhua:** Ua loa‘a mai ke ka‘a ‘ōhua hou, ua ho‘oponopono ‘ia ke ka‘a ‘ōhua kahiko, a ua hā‘awi ‘ia mai kekahi ka‘a ‘ōhua nui, no laila ‘ekolu nō ka‘a ‘ōhua i loa‘a i ke kula i kēia manawa. Ua ho‘omaika‘i ‘ia nā ka‘a ‘ekolu e Kumu Hi‘ipoi Kanahale, a kapa ‘ia kō lākou inoa ‘o Ka Mana‘o‘i‘o (ke ka‘a kahiko), Ka Mana‘olana (ke ka‘a hou), a me Ke Aloha (ke ka‘a nui i makana ‘ia mai). *The new bus has been delivered, the old bus has been repaired, and a large old bus has been given as a gift, so the school now has three buses. The three buses were blessed by Kumu Hi‘ipoi Kanahale and christened Ka Mana‘o‘i‘o (the old bus), Ka Mana‘olana (the new bus), and Ke Aloha (the large bus that was gifted to us).*
  
7. **Ka Hai ‘ana i Limahana no ka Hale Pā‘ina:** E kūkā hou ‘ia kēia kumuhana ma ka hui ‘ana o ke kōmike kūikawā no ka nānā ‘ana i ka mo‘ohelu kālā i loko o Mei. *This subject will be discussed again when the ad hoc committee for the budget meets in May.*
  
8. **Nā Kumuhana Hou aku:** ‘A‘ohe kumuhana hou i hāpai ‘ia i kēia manawa. *No new business was brought up at this time.*
