Moʻolelo no ka Hui Kūkā ʻana o ka Papa Alakaʻi o Ke Kula Niʻihau O Kekaha

Po'akolu, 18 'Okakopa 2023

Ua mālama 'ia ka hui kūkā 'ana o ka Papa Alaka'i ma ka lumi nui o ke kula. 'O nā lālā i hō'ea mai, 'o ia nō ka Pelekikena Kapua Phillips, ka Hope Pelekikena Keli'i Vidinha, ka Pu'ukū Hōkūlani Cleeland, ka lālā Thomas Milimili Nizo, nā lālā hou U'ilani Corr-Yorkman, Jolina Felix-Keamo'ai, a me Brenda Jose, ka lālā kū kūlana Tia Koerte, kekahi 'elele o ke Komikina Kula Ho'āmana Pua Ka'ai (z), a me ka wahine mālama kālā 'o Marissa Ibrao (z). 'A'ole i hō'ea mai 'o Tiffani Carlin a me Moana Niau. Ma o ka Zoom ka hui ana o ka po'e i ho'ike 'ia ka (z).

Ka Wehe 'ana:

I ka hola 3:06 o ka 'auinalā Po'akolu, lā 18 o 'Okakopa 2023, na Hōkūlani i wehe i ka hui kūkā 'ana me ka Pule Kahikolu, a na Kapua i alaka'i i ke kūkā 'ana i nā kumuhana ma ka papa kumumana'o o ka hui kūkā. At 3:06 p.m. on Wednesday, Octobr 18, 2023, Hōkūlani opened the meeting with the Pule Kahikolu, and Kapua led the discussion of items on the agenda.

Ka Hui Kūkā 'ana:

- 1. Ka Moʻolelo Kahiko: Ua ʻāpono ʻia ka moʻolelo o ka hui kūkā ʻana o ka lā 19 o lulai e like me ka mea i kākaʻahi ʻia. The minutes of the July 19 meeting were approved as distributed.
- 2. Ka Papa Kumumana'o no kēia Hui Kūkā 'ana: Ua 'āpono 'ia ka papa kumumana'o i hāpai 'ia e like me ka mea i kāka'ahi 'ia me ka ho'okomo pū 'ia o ho'okahi mana'o hou ma ka māhele no nā kumuhana hou aku. The proposed agenda was approved as distributed with the addition of one item for new business.
- 3. Ka Hōʻike Kālā: Ua kūkā ʻia ka hōʻike kālā no no ka hapahā mua e Marissa Ibrao ma o ka Zoom, a ua pane ʻo ia i kekahi mau nīnau e pili ana i ka hōʻike. Ua ʻāpono ʻia ka moʻohelu kālā no ka makahiki 2023-24 e like me ka mea i hōʻike ʻia. The financial report for the first quarter was discussed by Marissa Ibrao via Zoom, and she answered some questions about the report. The 2023-24 budget was approved as presented.

- 4. Ka Hō'ike Po'o Kumu: Eia kekahi o nā mana'o hou i hāpai 'ia e Tia ma kāna hō'ike po'o kumu: (a) Pahuhopu 3: Ua 'āpono 'ia ka ha'awina kālā he \$201,905 e KS Kaiaulu Aloha 'Āina no kēia makahiki no ka papahana Ulu Pono, a ke holomua nei ka hana. Ua 'āpono 'ia nō ho'i ka ha'awina kāla he \$115,360.43 ESSER III; he kālā ho'iho'i kēia, a pono nā mea a pau e pili ana i ka ma'i kolona, a hiki ke ho'ohana 'ia no ka halihali haumāna. (b) Pahuhopu 4: He 53 ka huinanui o nā haumāna ma ke kula i kēia manawa; ua piha loa ke kula pēpē me 12 haumāna, akā, 'ewalu wale nō haumāna ma ke kula ki'eki'e. (c) Pahuhopu 7: Pono e pau kekahi hō'ike no WASC i ke kupulau a me ka hā'ulelau 2025, a e kipa hope loa mai ana ke kōmike i ke kupulau 2026. The following new items were brought up by Tia in her administrator's report: (a) Goal 3: A grant of \$201,905 was was awarded by KS Kaiaulu Aloha 'Āina for this year to be used for the Ulu Pono project which is progressing at this time. An ESSER III grant of \$115,360.43 was also approved; this is a reimbursement grant, and all expenses must related to COVID-19, but it can be used for student transportation. Goal 4: Current enrollment is 53 students; the preschool is full with 12 students, but high school has only 8 students. Goal 7: A full self-study must be done for WASC during spring and fall 2025, and the committee will hold the final visit in spring 2026.
- 5. Nā Lālā a me nā Luna o ka Papa Alaka'i: Ua 'āpono 'ia 'ehā lālā hou no ka Papa Alaka'i, 'o ia nō 'o Tiffani Carlin, U'ilani Corr-Yorkman, Jolina Felix-Keamo'ai, a me Brenda Jose. Ua 'āpono 'ia ho'okahi luna hou, 'o ia nō 'o Jolina 'o ia ka pu'ukū hou, a ua lilo 'o Hōkūlani 'o ia ke kākau 'ōlelo. E mau ana nō ka pelekikena 'o Kapua a me ka hope pelekikena 'o Keli'i. Ua ho'oholo 'ia nō ho'i e lilo 'o Jolina i mea pūlima kīko'o no First Hawaiian Bank. 'A'ole i ho'oholo 'ia ke kūlana haumāna i kēia manawa. Four new Governing Board members were approved: Tiffani Carlin, U'ilani Corr-Yorkman, Jolina Felix-Keamo'ai, and Brenda Jose. One new officer was approved with Jolina chosen as the new treasurer, and Hōkūlani changed position to be secretary. President Kapua and vice-president Keli'i will continue. It was also decided that Jolina will be added as a signer for checks for First Hawaiian Bank. No decision was made as to having a student as a Board member.
- 6. Na Mīkini Hō'olu Ea Hou no ka Lumi 'Oki Leo: Ua 'āpono 'ia kā Alden Pablo hui 'o Kepa Services no \$37,000 no ka hana 'ana i nā mīkini hō'olu ea hou no ka lumi 'oki leo. The estimate of \$37,000 by Alden Pablo's company Kepa Services was approved to install new air conditioners in the studio.

- 7. Nā Kumuhana Hou aku: Kokoke pau ka hōʻoiaʻiʻo kālā no ka makahiki kula 2022-23. Ua noi ʻo Tia i nā lālā a pau o ka Papa Alakaʻi e pani i kekahi leka uila e ʻāpono ʻana i ia palapala ke pau. The audit for school year 2022-23 is almost completed. Tia asked that all the Board members reply to an email asking for approval of this document when it is finished.
- 8. Ka 'Āpono 'ana i nā Mea a pau: Ke 'āpono maoli nei ka Papa Alaka'i i nā mea a pau i hō'ike 'ia i loko o kēia mo'olelo. Everything covered in these minutes is hereby officially approved by the Governing Board.
