## Moʻolelo no ka Hui Kūkā ʻana o ka Papa Alakaʻi o Ke Kula Niʻihau O Kekaha

## Poʻakolu, 20 Iulai 2022

Ua mālama 'ia ka hui kūkā 'ana o ka Papa Alaka'i ma o ka Zoom. 'O nā lālā i hō'ea mai, 'o ia nō ka Pelekikena Kapua Phillips, ke Kākau 'Ōlelo Ka'i'ini Nī'au, ka Pu'ukū Hōkūlani Cleeland, nā lālā Keli'i Vidinha a me Thomas Nizo, a me ka lālā kū kūlana Tia Koerte. 'A'ole i hō'ea mai kekahi 'elele no ke Komikina Kula Ho'āmana.

#### Ka Wehe 'ana

I ka hola 3:33 o ka 'auinalā Po'akolu, lā 20 o Iulai 2022, na Hōkūlani i wehe i ka hui kūkā 'ana me ka Pule Kahikolu, a na Kapua i alaka'i i ke kūkā 'ana i nā kumuhana ma ka papa kumumana'o o ka hui kūkā. At 3:33 p.m. on Wednesday, July 20, 2022, Hōkūlani opened the meeting with the Pule Kahikolu, and Kapua led the discussion of items on the agenda.

#### Ka Hui Kūkā 'ana:

**1. Ka Moʻolelo Kahiko:** Ua ʻāpono ʻia ka moʻolelo o ka hui kūkā ʻana o ka lā 20 o ʻApelila e like me ka mea i kākaʻahi ʻia. *The minutes of the April 20 meeting were approved as distributed.*

2. Ka Papa Kumumana'o no kēia Hui Kūkā 'ana: Ua 'āpono 'ia ka papa kumumana'o i hāpai 'ia e like me ka mea i kāka'ahi 'ia me ke komo pū o kekahi māhele e pili ana i ka hana no ka ma'i kolona. The proposed agenda was approved as distributed with the addition of a section for Covid-19.

Noi 'ia: Keli'i Kōkua 'ia: Kapua 3. Ka Hōʻike Kālā: 'Oiai ua hana 'ia ka moʻohelu kālā no ka makahiki kula 2022–23 e Tia, Kapua, a me Hōkūlani, 'a'ole i nānā 'ia i kēia manawa. Na Malia Melchor i hana i ka hōʻike no ke kau 'ehā o ke kālā no ka makahiki 2021–22 a ua kūkā 'ia, eia na'e, 'a'ole i pau nā mea a pau o ia māhele a hiki i kēia manawa. Pono e nānā hou 'ia i loko o 'Okakopa. Although the budget for school year 2022–23 was made by Tia, Kapua, and Hōkūlani, it was not brought up at this time. Malia Melchor had prepared the financial report for the fourth quarter of 2021–22 and it was discussed, but it was still incomplete at this time and must be looked at again during the October meeting.

4. Ka Hōʻike Poʻo Kumu: Eia kekahi o nā manaʻo i hāpai ʻia e Tia ma kāna hōʻike poʻo kumu: (a) Pahuhopu 1: Ua hoʻolaha ʻia ka hai ʻana i kekahi kumu no ke kula waena; ʻaʻohe loaʻa a hiki i kēia manawa. (b) Pahuhopu 3: Mai ke aupuni mai no kēlā me kēia haumāna, he \$8,745 e hoʻonui ʻia e 53 haumāna, ʻo ia nō he \$463,485; ʻāpono ʻia \$150,000 mai Kamehameha mai no Hamline a me ka loʻi kalo, a me \$212,100 no ta polokalamu Ulu Aʻe; e hui ana ʻo Kapua, Thomas, a me Hōkūlani i hola 3:00 o ka lā 4 o ʻAukake no ke kūkā ʻana ma ka Zoom e pili ana i ka uku ʻana no kā Tia kūlana hana.

(c) Pahuhopu 7: E kipa mai ana kekahi kōmike no WASC i ka lā 10-11 o 'Apelila 2023; pono ka Papa Alaka'i e hui ma ka lā 24 o 'Aukake a me ka lā 7 o Kepakemapa no ka hana 'ana i ka hō'ike no nā mea i hāpai 'ia no ka papa alaka'i. (d) Nā mea 'ē a'e: Ua hō'ole mua 'ia ka noi 'ana i ke kālā Title I no tēia makahiki, akā, ke makemake nei lākou iā kākou e noi hou; ha'i 'ia 'o Tia e nānā inā kupono paha 'a'ole paha, a nāna nō e ho'oholo inā kūpono.

(d, hoʻomau ʻia) Ua hai ʻia o May Valenciano no ka hana ma ka hale pāʻina; he \$58,596 kāna e uku ʻia ana.

The following topics were discussed by Tia in her administrator's report: (a) Goal 1: An announcement had been made to hire a new teacher for middle school; no responses as of this time. (b) Goal 3: The per-pupil amount from the State this year is \$8,745, so multiplied by 53 students, the total is \$463,485; approved grants from Kamehameha Schools include \$150,000 for working with Hamline and the Yadao taro patch, and \$212,100 for the Ulu A'e project for reading; at 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 4, Kapua, Thomas, and Hōkūlani will meet via Zoom re Tia's position and pay.

(c) Goal 7: The WASC committee will be visiting the school on April 10–11, 2023; the Papa Alaka'i needs to meet on August 24 and September 7 to complete its report on items identified for the governing board. (d) Other business: It was decided to not ask for any Title I funding for this year, but the committee is asking that we submit a request; Tia was told to look at what they are offering, and if it's approproate, go ahead and ask, but she is authorized to decide whether or not it is worth it.

(d, continued): May Valenciano was hired to take charge of the cafeteria, and her salary will be \$58,596.
